Biography

Victor do Prado is currently the Director of the Council and TNC Division at the WTO. From 2005 to 2011, he worked as Deputy Chief of Staff to the Director-General of the WTO, Pascal Lamy. He previously served as a

Counsellor in the WTO Rules Division where he acted as a Secretary of the WTO Committee on Subsidies and Countervailing Measures. Prior to joining the WTO, Victor do Prado was a Brazilian diplomat. During his post in Geneva a

Brazilian negotiator, he held the position of Chairman of the Subsidies Committee and was a Panelist in various Dispute Settlement cases. Victor do Prado holds a Degree in Law from the University of São Paulo and a Master in

International Relations from the Brazilian Diplomatic Academy. He has lectured at the University of Paris, the Freie Universität Berlin and at Georgetown University Law School.
